Dear P7 Parent

We look forward to welcoming our P7 pupils back to school next week. Your child is due to start back to school on Monday 24th August at the time specified on the letter you received in June. The first week will be on a part-time basis until 12.00 each day. Pupils will be dismissed from the infant door at the front of the building at 12.00. We would ask that parents respect the 2m social distancing guidelines if you are waiting for your child on the school grounds. There will be no school meals provision so pupils will need to bring a break to school each day. There will be no bus service running until 1st September.

No schoolbags should be brought to school for the time being. Anything which needs to be sent home will be sent in a plastic document wallet. Pupils may bring a pencil case but this will stay on their desk in school and not be going home every evening. They may also bring a reusable water bottle which they will have to sanitize on entering school and before leaving school. Training shoes may be worn to school, thus avoiding extra bags being brought into school.

Building work is taking place in the school kitchen so there may be some congestion at the back of the school. All P7 pupils should enter the school building via the double doors of the assembly hall including those pupils going to the mobile.

Homework can be accessed through the school website although paper copies of transfer tests will have to be sent home for completion.

The P7 pupils will be working a two separate groups until lunchtime Monday to Thursday, but will be taught as a single until in the afternoons and all day each Friday. We hope that this arrangement gives all our P7 pupils a chance to consolidate their learning and make up for lost time in school. This arrangement will continue for Term 1.
